

Syllabus of Class II Session (2018-19)

The current curriculum has been prepared according to the pattern laid by CBSE. The main focus is on the overall development of the child. A child should be happy, fulfilled and excited to learn new things. Self esteem and confidence should also develop as a part of learning process.

Parents are requested not to send any extra book or note-book in their ward's bag. Books and note books to be carried in the bag by the child as mentioned -

ASSESSMENT TECHNIQUE

Evaluation and teaching go hand in hand. Our assessment technique has been designed to evaluate child's all round development and day to day performance in the class. Our aim is teaching by doing.

1. Children will be assessed on the basis of written as well as oral tests.
 2. If the child is absent in any test (written as well as oral), he/she will be given average marks on the basis of verified medical certificate.
 3. Written tests will be shown to the parents only on Parent Teacher Meet.
 4. Only grades will be awarded.
 5. Weekly Test (only one subject) will be taken on every Monday for internal assessment.
 5. The annual assessment will be based on 4 periodic tests
